## AFFI President & CEO Kraig R. Naasz Named to Key U.S. Chamber of Commerce Leadership Group

Founded in 1958, the C-100 is comprised of the nation's leading trade association chief executives and serves as the primary policy-originating body for the U.S. Chamber of Commerce. The committee also enhances the U.S. Chamber's lobbying and coalition efforts, and works to expand the organization's outreach to the business and trade association communities.

The C-100 meets twice a year, typically in June and December, and is currently chaired by American Beverage Association President and CEO Susan Neely.
