She also spent four years conducting dietary risk assessments for the food and beverage industries with Technical Assessment Systems and then Environ International Corporation.

In accepting the position, Bodor said, "I am honored to have been selected to lead AFFI and look forward to working with the outstanding staff, members and AFFI Board of Directors to advance the public policy objectives of the frozen food and beverage category."

Bodor holds an MBA from the University of Maryland and a bachelor's degree in Food Science from Cornell University.
